**Tell us the title and publisher of your book:** Deadly Exchange, iUniverse, Inc.

**Tell us about yourself:** I knew that I wanted to be a storyteller by the time I was eight years old. I remember my first story (not required by schooling) that I wrote. Of course, it was silly. Unfortunately, I drifted from the truth of this calling by the age of fifteen and took on many distractions (also called careers). I have no regrets because I drew from those other experiences to write *Deadly Exchange*. Part of that past was being trained as a federal agent and recruitment by the CIA (which I didn't join). Later, I authored an education system for health care professionals called, *Muscle Balance and Function Development*®, which led me to travel the western world giving lectures and workshops, which I still do. **Give us an overview of your book:** What if the company you work for could control your mind?

**What inspired you to write this book?** Originally, much of it had been incubating unconsciously. Once it became conscious, I felt the story of lost identity, both of the individual and a nation, with the backdrop of manipulation by larger entities (such as corporations and governments), and the terror of technology must be told.

**How is your book different from other books in this genre?** While the themes of self-discovery and identity play strongly throughout the story, as it pertains to both the individual and a nation, it also affords the reader a deeper look into the conflict between the beliefs of the conditioned mind (outer self that lives in the world) and the power and truth of sentience (the inner self). This is particularly aimed at females, not because they are in a worse situation in this regard; rather I feel they will be the ones to lead humanity (and Earth's creatures) into a more heart-centered existence.

**Are you working on another book? If so when do you expect it to be published?** My second novel is close to completion. It is more a mystery and literary novel. Perhaps it will hit the streets in a year and a half.
